ACSC Sailing Instructor Job Description

About us:

Alameda Community Sailing Center (ACSC) is a charitable non-profit 501(c)3 organization. Our mission is to provide opportunities to participate in sailing on San Francisco Bay through access and education.

Job Summary:

Sailing Instructors create a safe, fun, and educational experience for sailing students ages 7-99. We teach beginner-intermediate dinghy sailing in a protected cove on the SF Bay. Sailboats launch from a beach, and Instructors primarily teach from small powerboats. Sailing Instructors report to the Program Director.

Terms:

Part-Time or Full-Time (Spring, Summer, & Fall)

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teach Beginner through Intermediate sailing skills via chalk talks, land drills, and on-water drills and games
- Lead groups of 6-12 students
- Assist with the development of curriculum, sailing games, and adventure sails
- Be risk management-focused, on and off water
- Assist in light maintenance of equipment and upkeep of facility
- Provide daily written reports

Minimum Requirements:

- US Sailing Level 1 Small Boat Instructor certification
- CPR and First Aid
- SafeSport Certification
- Heads Up Training
- LiveScan background check

Compensation:

\$18.21 per hour for first-time Sailing Instructors, with \$1.04 raises for each year of experience and each additional relevant certification (lifeguard, Level 2 training, etc.)
