ACSC Lead Instructor Job Description

The role of Lead Instructor requires: good communication and creative problem solving; strong leadership and organizational skills; ability to be flexible and adaptable, and provide outstanding customer service. Represent ACSC's core values and mission.

Programs

- Collaborate with Program Director to create and implement curriculum for staff training
- Serve as the leader of the Instructors, Assistant Instructors, and CITs
- Youth sail camp:
 - Collaborate with Program Director to create and implement camp curriculum
 - Instruct summer camp sessions
- Teach the Siebel Sailors Program at ACSC.
 - o Regularly communicate with the regional Siebel Coach, and
 - o Utilize the resources provided to us as a Siebel Center as effectively as possible.
- Adult and family programs:
 - Teach Learn-to-Sail classes for adults and families
 - Teach Intermediate Adult Sailing classes
- Participate in community activities hosted by ACSC

Safety

- Promote a culture of safety among staff and participants
- Be familiar with, and enforce, safety protocols among staff and participants
- Perform "boat checks" before boats leave the yard, and ensure that other staff do so as well
- Manage multiple groups on water and land with a strong focus on risk management

Facilities & Budget

- Maintain a clean and organized site
- Make sure damaged equipment is reported to Program Director and taken out of service
- Assist with boat maintenance and repairs when not teaching classes
- Set the example of cautious and prudent boat/equipment care
- Assist with power boat haul-outs and launches

Professional training

- Attend annual US Sailing training meeting
- Attend US Sailing Instructor certification courses

 Provide End of Day reports and follow up with other Instructors to make sure all daily paperwork is completed and submitted to the Program Director.
